WILLIAMSBURG, VA – The Missing in America Project in the commonwealth of Virginia will conduct a ceremony and honor seventy-five cremated remains who were left at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, DC.

In cooperation with the National Park Service, the service will be conducted with full military honors at 11:00am, Sunday, November 17, 2018, at Woodbine Cemetery in Manassas, Virginia.

The purpose of the Missing in American Project is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of veterans through the joint efforts of private, state and federal organizations; to provide honor and respect to those who have serve this country by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes.
